

Minutes for a meeting held on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2023, at the Abbey Room, St Giles Church, Croxden ST14 5JG. The meeting commenced at 7pm.

## ROAD SIGNAGE for Bends - ALTON LANE/SANDY LANE, GREATGATE - UPDATE

SCC confirmed on 19.06.2023 they will install 2 signs on Alton Lane and the Parish Council asked for the bend signs at the following locations:

From Alton direction to Great Gate will be erected at the boundary point for Croxden parish, which is close to Spond Farm. The sign should indicate bends for 2 miles along Alton Lane. From Great Gate direction to Alton will be erected on the section between where Alton Lane starts at Great Gate and Holly Bank property (ST10 4HF), again indicating bends for 2 miles along the lane.

Councillors noted the update and asked Clerk to write to SCC thanking them for their support of this project.

### **BEAMHURST (A522) - TRAFFIC CALMING - UPDATE**

Clerk wrote to SCC to ask if they wanted the proposed plans for traffic calming to be shared with residents. SCC Plans are: "SCC would propose to use edge of carriageway markings in advance of and through the vehicle access points. This will help to move traffic towards the centre line and highlight a change in road conditions."

Cllr Atkins agreed for these plans to be shared with residents and for the Parish Council to collate responses. 09.06.2023

Resident residents responded by providing the Parish Council with a letter, see Appendix A, which the Council RESOLVED to send to SCC.

The Parish Council are happy to hold an extraordinary meeting, if SCC want to discuss further solutions with residents.

## **ALTON TOWERS COMMUNITY LIAISON MEETING**

Clerk contacted Deborah Harris (Alton Towers) and Oakamoor PC asking for a meeting to



discuss traffic regulation for Nabb Lane. The meeting will take place at Alton Towers Hotel Conference Centre on Thursday 24th August.1:30pm. Cllr James and Cllr Hall confirmed attendance.

## PARISH COMMUNITY WALK – 11<sup>TH</sup> July 2023 – UPDATE

Poster in Noticeboards, on FB, in Church, on website and at Wood Farm Walk took place at Wood Farm, Greatgate on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2023 at 6.30pm.

Councillors noted that 13 residents came to the walk. 2 from Cheadle, 1 from Great Gate, 4 from Hollington, Parish Councillors + 2 spouse and the feedback was encouraging, and people enjoyed learning about the history of the woods. Councillors noted it was fascinating to see the many Bronze Age remains at Wood Farm and learn about the community that lived here, in our parish, at that time.

Councillors RESOLVED for the next walk to take place on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2023 at 6.30pm – meeting at St Giles Church and the walk will be to the historic Clapper Bridge on Pointhorne Farm, with refreshments afterwards at St Giles Church.

#### **HOLLINGTON ROAD - SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION REQUEST - UPDATE**

A letter was sent to SCC to ask for an update on the request to reduce the speed limit from 60mph – 40mph on the roman road section of Hollington Road, in order that JCB Traffic Management can carry out speed watch duties. Speed Watch Team by residents will be set up once speed limit reduced. Letter sent to Cllr Williams, Cllr Clements, Cllr Ward and Mr Lindop (SCC Scrutiny Committee Support)

SCC – Hollington Road, Speed Limit Reduction letter – sent to Cllr David Williams and the Scrutiny Committee at SCC to ask for a review of the request to have Hollington Road speed limit reduced to 40mph so that both residents and JCB Speed Watch Teams can operate by Keelings Lane junction.

No Response from SCC at time of Meeting and Clerk will follow up.

#### 23.07.006 PESTICIDES SPRAYING WITHIN THE PARISH – DISCUSS

A resident of Croxden contacted the Council concerned about pesticides use in Croxden and impact on wildlife and human health.

Councillors discussed the letter and noted the concerns and after research, advised they can only advise residents that the Health and Safety Executive and DEFRA closely monitor all spraying and any further research can be obtained by visiting the HSE website and look for the Health and Safety code of practice for using plant protection products.

The Parish Council would not be able to find out what chemicals are being used and is not within the Councils remit.

The Council discussed the request for prior warning from Farmers before spraying takes place and concluded that due to the nature of the variables involved before spraying this would not be practical.
